QUALIFICATIONS: Applicant must be a fully qualified member of the Judge Advocate General's Corps and a member in good standing of the practicing State's Bar Association. A minimum of 3 months experience in legal assignments, after designation as a judge advocate by Judge Advocate General, is mandatory. Experience must include serving as trial or defense counsel in courts-martial; preparing legal briefs or rendering advice relating to interpreting laws, regulations, directives, status, rights, liabilities, and duties of military personnel and dependents.

DUTIES: Manages and provides legal services to preserve prerogatives of the United States Air Force and the Tennessee Air National Guard and their commanders. Performs duties prescribed by Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ) pursuant to Manual for Courts-Martial, United States, 1995 (MCM), Tennessee Code 58 (annotated) and prepares and provides legal opinions and decisions necessary for efficient and effective discharge of mission of the United States Air Force and the Tennessee Air National Guard. Specialty encompasses administration of military justice, including counsel on disciplinary matters, pretrial advice, preparation for trial, trials by courts-martial, post-trial actions, and appellate review. Renders legal advice to commanders on all phases of Air Force and Tennessee National Guard operations, including state law, international law, operations law, procurement, claims, environmental law, military and civilian personnel issues, patents, litigation, military affairs, legal assistance and preventive law, taxes, and allied legal matters that fall under the purview of the Department of Defense or the Tennessee Military Department.
